PROCEDURES

INDIVIDUAL LOG BOOK FOR AERONAUTICAL PERSONNEL

1. Authority

This advisory circular is issued by the Executive Chairman of the Instituto de Aviação Civil de Moçambique (IACM) in pursuance of powers vested in him under Article 31 of Law 21/2009 of 21 September and Article 12 of Resolution 19/2011 of 30 November.

2. Background

This AIS is published in order to ensure that the Civil Aviation Authority of the Republic of Mozambique has sufficient control over the flight hours, maintenance work hours and leisure activities performed by the holders of aeronautical licenses and other aeronautical personnel with a view at checking and improving the technical competence.

3. Objective

This AIC aims at establishing rules for the individual log books of the flight crew members, maintenance personnel, flight dispatchers and aeronautical sportsmen to serve as documented evidence of the compulsory recording of flight hours, work time or specific activities performed.

4. Applicability

This AIC is applicable to all aeronautical personnel performing aeronautical activities over Mozambican territory.

5. Procedures

- 5.1. The holder of a license shall record flight time, or work hours, or leisure activities performed under the terms of the license.
- 5.2. The individual log book shall be stamped by the Aviation Authority or its representative on the page indicating the hours at the end of every month in order to confirm that the hours recorded have been performed.
- 5.3. The individual log book shall be shown to IACM officers upon request.
- 5.4. The format of the information contained in the log book is described in the documents MOZCAR part 61 and 66.
- 5.5. It is not allowed to erase or to add remarks or signatures in the log books. The only stamps allowed are those of the Civil Aviation Authority IACM or of its representatives.
